Entrance Hallway

The entrance hall consisting of doorways to the kitchen and lounge/diner, wood effect flooring, a fitted light to the ceiling and carpeted stairs rising to the first floor.









The property is located on a quiet no through road within walking distance to the town centre of Aylesbury, providing a train station, shops and leisure facilities. Local schools include Elmhurst School (Infant Catchment), the Aylesbury Vale Academy (Secondary Comprehensive) and the Aylesbury High and Grammar Schools.











Kitchen

This kitchen is comprised of wood effect flooring, window to the front aspect, an inset sink with a mixer tap and draining board, an inset dishwasher, fridge/freezer, double oven, electric stove and extractor.

Lounge/Diner

This lounge/diner is comprised of carpeted flooring, window to the rear aspect, door to the enclosed rear garden, studio spotlights to the ceiling, a door to an under stairs storage cupboard, wall mounted radiator and space for living and dining room furniture.

Landing

The first floor landing is comprised of carpeted flooring, a fitted light to the ceiling, and doors to a storage cupboard, two bedrooms and the bathroom.

Bathroom

This bathroom is comprised of fully tiled walls, a frosted window, low level w/c, a wall mounted radiator, panelled bathtub with a mixer tap and overhead shower and a hand wash basin with taps.

Bedroom

This bedroom features carpeted flooring, a window to the front aspect, a wall mounted radiator, studio spotlights to the ceiling and space for a single bed and other bedroom furniture.

Bedroom

This bedroom is comprised of carpeted flooring, a window to the rear aspect, pendant light to the ceiling, a wall mounted radiator, inset wall-to-wall wardrobes and space for a double bed and other bedroom furniture.

Garden

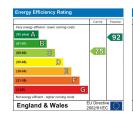
This enclosed rear garden is comprised of a concrete pathway through the garden, grass lawn to the remainder and a gate to the rear with access to the parking.
