Three storey cottage with two double bedrooms and two reception rooms located at the top end of the High Street, beautifully restore throughout with a wealth of Character features.

The Property

This property has been skilfully improved by the current owners and offers two reception rooms and two double bedrooms. There are stripped floorboards and doors throughout, sash windows with shutters and a gas combi boiler. As you enter the property into the sitting room there is a wood burning stove with a wooden mantel over and shelving and cupboards in the chimney recess. The living room then opens through to a dining room with stairs to first floor and fireplace with a shelved corner cupboard. The kitchen has a range of wall and base shaker style units, integrated ceramic hob, oven and hood, dishwasher and free-standing washer/dryer, fridge/freezer, Wine Fridge and a wall mounted gas boiler and part tiled walls. Rear door leads out to the patio garden.

Upstairs on the first floor is a double bedroom with a window to the front. The recently re-fitted bathroom has a large shower with a glass screen, panelled bath, Low level w/c, wash hand basin. Stairs rise to the second-floor bedroom which is double aspect with dormer windows, shelving in chimney recess and a hatch to loft.

Outside is a walled paved patio with raised shrub beds, outside tap and light.

The Location


Lewes is the county town of East Sussex, nestled within the South Downs National Park, with a direct fast train service to London. Highly regarded infant and primary schools are an easy walk as are Priory Secondary School, Sussex Downs College and Lewes Old Grammar School.









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Ground Floor Approximate Floor Area 329.05 sq ft (30.57 sq m)
