

Tom Thumb Barn, Laughton

Situated just outside the village of Laughton, on the edge of the South Downs National Park and less than 8 miles from Lewes, Tom Thumb Barn has planning permission to be converted in to a 1,237 sq. ft. single storey residential dwelling.

The plot measures circa 0.64 of an acre, is accessed from the main Lewes Road B214 and has an electrical supply, mains water and sceptic tank. Currently there is a brick built stable building measuring circa 45ft x 10ft and Tom thumb Barn measuring circa 40ft x 30ft. The planning permission allows for the conversion of the barn and creation of what could be an impressive single storey residential property spanning 1,237 sq. ft. with a stunning outlook across open fields. In order to affect the planning permission the current owners have made a substantial start by replacing the sceptic tank and installing new pipework to the barn.
