The Property


Front door with stairs leading upstairs to communal entrance hall. Wooden front door leading into entrance hall with deep cloaks cupboard, with plumbing for washing machine and air purification system. Door to bedroom one with a window to the side. Door to bedroom two with a built-in wardrobe with sliding doors. Bathroom fitted with a modern suite comprising of a panelled bath with a shower over, glass shower screen, wash hand basin and concealed WC, chrome heated towel rail, part tiled walls and tiled floor. Kitchen/dining/lounge is open plan and the kitchen area is fitted with a good range of contemporary style units with an inset gas hob, matching oven and extractor fan, built in fridge/freezer, stainless steel sink with mixer taps over and a Worcester gas fired boiler concealed in the cupboard. Window to the side and sliding doors onto the balcony which is of a good size and offers those a view across the town. Allocated parking space and outside storage cupboard for bikes.

Lewes is the county town of East Sussex, nestled within the South Downs National Park, with a direct fast train service to London. The station which is within walking distance, offers links to London in just over an hour and Brighton in under 20 minutes. The internationally recognised Glyndebourne Opera House is located approx 4 miles from Lewes. Highly regarded infant and primary schools are an easy walk as are Priory Secondary School, Sussex Downs College and Lewes Old Grammar School.
