The Property

A rare opportunity for purchasers to acquire a very attractive parcel of sloping mixed broadleaved woodland with some conifers. Occupying a quiet, peaceful position on the flanks of Hatway Hill, just north of Harcombe, within the East Devon AONB. The woodland enjoys fine views over this pretty valley and towards the coast beyond.

The vendors purchased Buddle Wood some 15 years ago, during their ownership they have improved the property by constructing a superb track that provides access in a loop around the woodland – excellent for walking and for timber extraction purposes. They have also installed some basic facilities including:-

- 1. Timber Field Shelter (used for machinery storage)
- 2. Timber Storage Shed
- 3. Timber composting WC and hand basin
- 4. Seating area for BBQ's/ camping

The woodland is accessed from the highway via a level hard track known as Green Lane (approximately 0.60 of a mile from the highway), this leads to a shared parking area giving ample parking for 2/3 vehicles. The woodland is mainly sloping with some clearings. The main species include Oak, Beech, Birch, Rowan and Holly – there are a number of significant mature trees, areas of naturally regenerated coppice and a some conifers close to the southern boundary.

The vendors regularly see badger, deer and wonderful birdlife. The woodland is also currently home to two colonies of bees (please take care of the hives when viewing)

Services

None connected. Rainwater is harvested from the buildings.

Rights of Way

A public footpath crosses the northern edge of the woodland. There is a formal right of way over the access track for Buddle Wood.
