Stourton adjoins the neighbouring village of Cherington and within the village there is a fine parish Church, good village pub, new village hall and The Cotswold Distillery. Good local community with a monthly farmers market and regular community activities. In addition, the house benefits from superfast broadband and has access to numerous public footpaths and bridleways locally.

Neighbouring villages of Upper and Lower Brailes offer a good variety of local amenities including a butcher, general store, newsagent and bakery, together with a primary school, garage and Roman Catholic chapel.

In addition, there is an 18-hole golf course at Sutton under Brailes. There are several sports facilities in Shipston including a leisure centre with swimming pool.

The local town of Shipston on Stour, together with the market towns of Moreton in Marsh and Chipping Norton offer a more comprehensive range of facilities. The larger centres of Banbury, Stratford upon Avon, Oxford, Warwick and Leamington Spa are easily accessible. Junction 11 and 14 of the M40 Motorway are at Banbury and Warwick

Mainline rail stations at Banbury and Moreton in Marsh with services south to Oxford and London respectively. In addition, from Banbury there is a train service to London (Marylebone) in just under an hour.



Trains north from Stratford and Warwick Parkway to Birmingham and onwards.

**16 The Long Close** is an impressive, spacious and well-presented stone village house quietly situated on the edge of the Cotswolds with outstanding far-reaching views over the surrounding farmland and countryside.

An important feature of the property is the impressive dining kitchen situated next to the garden room with outstanding views. In addition, the kitchen and bathrooms are well appointed.

From the spacious **Reception Hall** with oak boarded flooring, door to the **Sitting Room** with dressed stone fireplace incorporating a wood burning stove and double French doors to garden.

**Dining Kitchen** well appointed with built-in base and wall units, glazed china double sink unit, two-hob three-oven electric ESSE cooker, porcelain tiled floor with glazed door to **Garden Room** with double French doors to the garden, stone tiled floor.

Well-appointed **Utility Room** with fitted wall units and stable door to garden, porcelain tiled floor.

Study with door to Integral Double Garage. Cloakroom.

Spacious Part-Galleried Landing with airing cupboard, Principal Bedroom having far-reaching views, Ensuite Shower room leading through to Dressing Room.



Two further **Double Bedrooms** both with built in wardrobes and **Ensuite Shower Rooms**.

On the second floor **Spacious Landing** with **Double Bedroom Four** and spacious **Family Bathroom** with store cupboard.

Integral Double Garage with light, power and water connected, HRM Wallstar oil-fired boiler for central heating and hot water, personnel door to garden, electric up and over door, off road parking for two/three cars in front.

**The Garden**, which adjoins farmland with outstanding views over the surrounding countryside, is an important feature of the property, is enclosed and has been attractively landscaped.

Immediately adjoining the house is a stone paved patio with the garden being principally lawned with well stocked flower and shrub borders, together with a beech and thorn hedge. In addition, there are a variety of apple and ornamental trees.
