

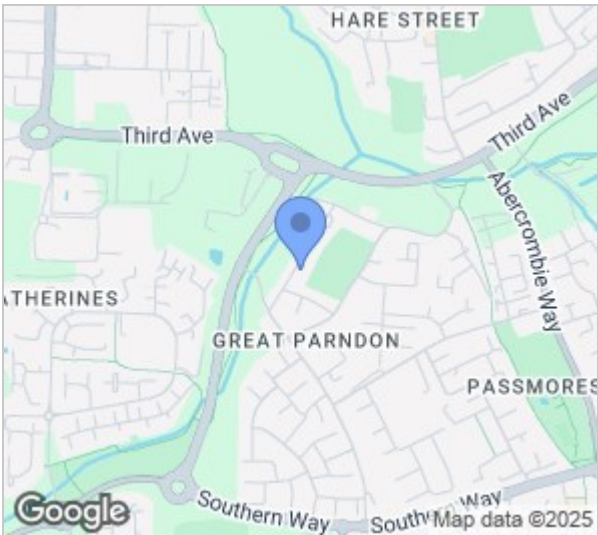
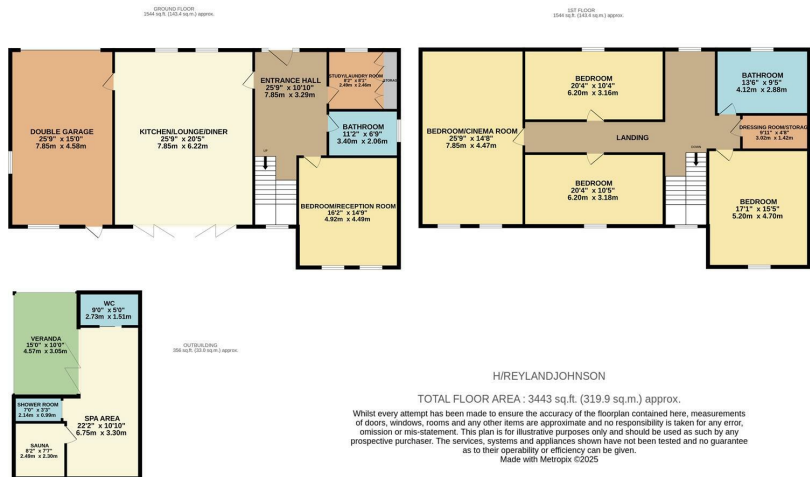

As you enter there is a large hallway leading to a huge 20ft x 26ft kitchen/lounge/diner, with a range of fitted wall and base units with integrated appliances, an island/breakfast bar, bi-fold doors and a feature gas fire, a large bedroom/reception room, beautiful bathroom and a study/laundry room. Upstairs there are four large double bedrooms, one of which is being used as a cinema room, a stunning family bathroom and a spacious landing with a seating area. Outside, the large rear garden is mainly laid to lawn with various seating and patio areas, plus an outbuilding including a hot tub and seating area, showers, a toilet and a sauna (which could be converted into an annexe). Other benefits include an integral double garage and a large driveway, underfloor heating in all bathrooms and the entire outbuilding and an alarm system throughout. Hawkenbury is located in the highly desirable area of Harlow, known as 'The Parks', just off Paycock Road, with excellent schools, shops and open fields within walking distance.
