Kitchen

Ample storage in a range of floor and eye-level units accompanied by a single drainer sink with mixer tap. Integrated appliances to include electric oven, four ring gas hob, and extractor above. Further space for fridge freezer and plumbing for washing machine. Window to front aspect.

Living/Dining Room

Generously sized living-dining room with understairs storage cupboard and French doors opening onto the back garden.

The village of Lea benefits from a modern primary school, post office, village store, church, and garage. Lea is situated approx 6.43 km (4 miles) west of the market town of Ross-on-Wye with superb road links to Gloucester, Cheltenham, and Hereford. M50 is close by offering excellent motorway links across the country.

To the front of the property is a driveway granting parking for two vehicles. Accessed via the side gate, the back garden offers a combination of lawned and patio areas accompanied by a garden shed.




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
