TAKE A LOOK AROUND

An entrance porch and hall welcome you into the home, providing a lovely first impression and built-in storage. On the left is the large living and dining room, which spans the entire depth of the property. Dual-aspect windows ensure a cascade of daily light, whilst the neutral décor further elevates the airy ambience. A handsome focal-point fireplace frames the lounge area, leaving plenty of room for a table and chairs as well. Next door, the kitchen has a galley-style arrangement, fitted with wood-toned cabinets at base and wall level, alongside complementary worktops and splashback tiles. The kitchen comes with all the appliances included (no guarantees provided).

HEAD ON UP

Upstairs, the three bedrooms are lightly decorated and laid with soft carpets. The principal and second bedrooms are large doubles with built-in wardrobes, whereas the third bedroom is a versatile space equipped with a store cupboard. Bedrooms two and three also boast spectacular country and hillside views – an inspiring backdrop to wake up to. A bright three-piece bathroom (with an overhead shower) finishes the property. Gas central heating and double glazing ensure year-round comfort.

TOUR THE GROUNDS

The home has a lovely front garden that adds to the property's kerb appeal and it has a large rear garden that is fully enclosed and with a suntrap aspect. Laid with a sweeping lawn and framed by plant beds, the rear garden is perfect for families. A front driveway and attached garage (with garden access) provide private parking for two cars.



MELROSE

Melrose is a charming country town, nestled in the Tweed Valley and overlooked by the three peaks of the Eildon Hills. The magnificent ruins of Melrose Abbey, where the heart of Robert the Bruce is said to rest, are a joy to explore, alongside idyllic gardens managed by the National Trust for Scotland. Locals and tourists can enjoy a delightful array of independent shops lining the high street, in addition to essential shopping with small supermarkets, a deli, a greengrocer, bakeries, a butcher, and a pharmacy. There is also a public library and a delightful selection of restaurants, takeaways, quaint cafés, and cosy pubs for refreshment after shopping and sightseeing. Melrose boasts a wonderful community atmosphere, enhanced by an exciting calendar of festivals and events. Highlights each year include the Borders Book Festival, the Pipe Band Championships, and the international Melrose Sevens, the town's biggest sporting event, as the birthplace of Rugby Sevens. While rugby union is particularly popular, golfers and cricketers can also find local clubs, and the stunning ancient landscape surrounding the town is a haven for pursuits such as hiking, hill running (marked by an annual race), and fishing along the River Tweed. In terms of education, Melrose offers independent schooling and state education at nursery and primary levels. A high school option is available in Earlston, while further education can be pursued at Borders College in Galashiels-both are just a 10-minute drive away. The town is well-connected, with a regular bus timetable, and Edinburgh is reachable in an hour by car or train from nearby Tweedbank.
