Charters Towers was formerly a manor house dating back to 1900 which later became the Adeline Genee Theatre and attracted world renowned ballet dancers, Dame Margot Fonteyn and Rudolph Nureyev.

The extensive accommodation covers an impressive 967 sq ft and briefly comprises; spacious entrance hall with a large storage cupboard; Lounge/dining room with French doors to the balcony; modern fitted kitchen which has a range of wall and base level units, 4 ring electric hob with overhead extractor fan, electric oven and dishwasher; master bedroom with fitted wardrobes and a en suite shower room which has WC and wash hand basin; family bathroom which has a WC, wash hand basin and bath; double guest bedroom with rear aspect views completes the living accommodation.

The apartment further benefits from underfloor heating with individual room controls and a 24 hour emergency response system in all rooms.















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
