The Property

The front door leads into the entrance hall with a staircase rising to the first floor. To the left of the property, you will find an 18' sitting room with uPVC window overlooking the rear garden that has ample space for seating and a dining table. The kitchen is located to the rear of the property and has a worktop with inset stainless steel sink and drainer with cupboards beneath, a further worktop with cupboards and drawers under, space for freestanding electric cooker, wall mounted extractor fan, matching wall cupboards, tiled splashbacks, uPVC sealed unit double glazed window overlooking rear garden and matching rear entrance door. From the entrance hall a door leads into a wet room with a W/C, hand wash basin, wall mounted electric shower and opaque uPVC sealed unit double glazed window. Staircase rises to the first floor and landing leading to all four separate bedrooms which all have uPVC windows and the main bedroom has a fitted double cupboard.





External

Outside to the front, is a concrete path and lawned front garden leading to the main entrance. To the rear is a large fully enclosed garden mainly laid to lawn, with concrete path. An external brick store provides outside storage.

Location

The historical market Town of Bungay lies in the Waveney Valley and is some five and a half miles west of the bustling market town of Beccles. Bungay has bus services to Norwich, Halesworth and Beccles. The town has a number of independent shops, as well as pubs, restaurants and a theatre.


