#### **Communal Entrance**

With security automated doors to the front elevations opening to a reception area where the house managers office is located, a corridor proceeds through to the communal lounge, lift and staircase giving access to the second floor.

#### **Second Floor**

##### **Entrance Hallway**

With private entrance door, fitted 24-hour Tunstall emergency response system, hall mounted security door entry system unit with intercom, recessed ceiling spotlights, solid wooden doors to:

##### **Utility Cupboard**

Useful utility/storage cupboard with tiled flooring, fitted NEFF washer/dryer, boiler and Vent Axia system.

##### **Bedroom**

15'5 max x 13'11 max (4.70m max x 4.24m max)

Generous bedroom with window overlooking to communal

gardens, wall mounted electric radiator/heater and large walk-in wardrobe with fitted storage cupboard, fitted hanging rail, shelving and draws.

##### **Shower Room**

Fitted with a contemporary suite comprising 'white gloss' vanity unit with low level W.C with concealed cistern and inset wash-hand basin with fitted storage beneath, wall mounted illuminated mirror, large walk-in level access shower, stainless steel heated towel rail, tiled flooring with under floor heating and part tiled walls.

##### **Communal Gardens**

Accessed via patio doors from the communal lounge the landscaped gardens are a particular feature of Oak Tree Court and offer a selection of brick paved seating areas with a selection of established beds planted with a selection mature shrubs and selection of mature trees, a pathway leads down to an area lawn which proceeds to the rear/side of the development with a number of benches.
