Charming traditional lower garden apartment situated at the top of Townhill Road and on entry to the village of Townhill with the Country Park and Loch a two minute walk away. This property is ideal for first time buyers and couples looking for an easy to maintain home on the level with the benefit of good outdoor space with garden and patio area. The accommodation is well presented and briefly comprises entrance vestibule, lounge with open plan aspect to fitted galley kitchen, two bedrooms and shower room. There are small gardens to the front and a side path leads to the rear where there is a section of lawn and patio. The property is double glazed with gas central heating and early entry is available.









LOCATION

The ancient capital of Dunfermline won its bid to have official city status in May 2022, as part of the civic honour's competition to celebrate the Queen's platinum jubilee. The City of Dunfermline is of considerable historic interest and is the resting place of King Robert the Bruce. Carnegie's Birthplace museum, the Abbey and Abbot House reflect the historic interest of the city, whilst recent developments have seen Dunfermline move into the modern era with Carnegie Museum and Library. Dunfermline is located approximately five miles from the Forth bridges and is therefore particularly popular with commuters to Edinburgh and many parts of the central belt with easy access to the M90 motorway with its direct links to Edinburgh, Perth and Dundee and across the Kincardine Bridge by way of motorways to Stirling, Glasgow and the West. It benefits from a full range of shops, social and leisure facilities and educational establishments. The local railway stations provide a regular service to Edinburgh with intercity links to other parts of the UK. There are regular and convenient bus services both local and national.
















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
