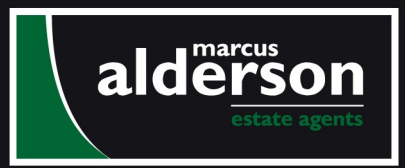

The particulars of sale held at The Kings Head Hotel in May 1907 stated: Lot 3.- All those Two CLOSES of MEADOW or PASTURE LAND, with the Loose Boxes, Hay Shed, and Hen Houses, erected thereon in Gallow Fields Lane, in the Parish of Richmond...
