Plus, Burham village is a mere 23-minute drive (14 miles) from Ebbsfleet International Station, offering frequent trains to London St. Pancras in as little as 19 minutes.

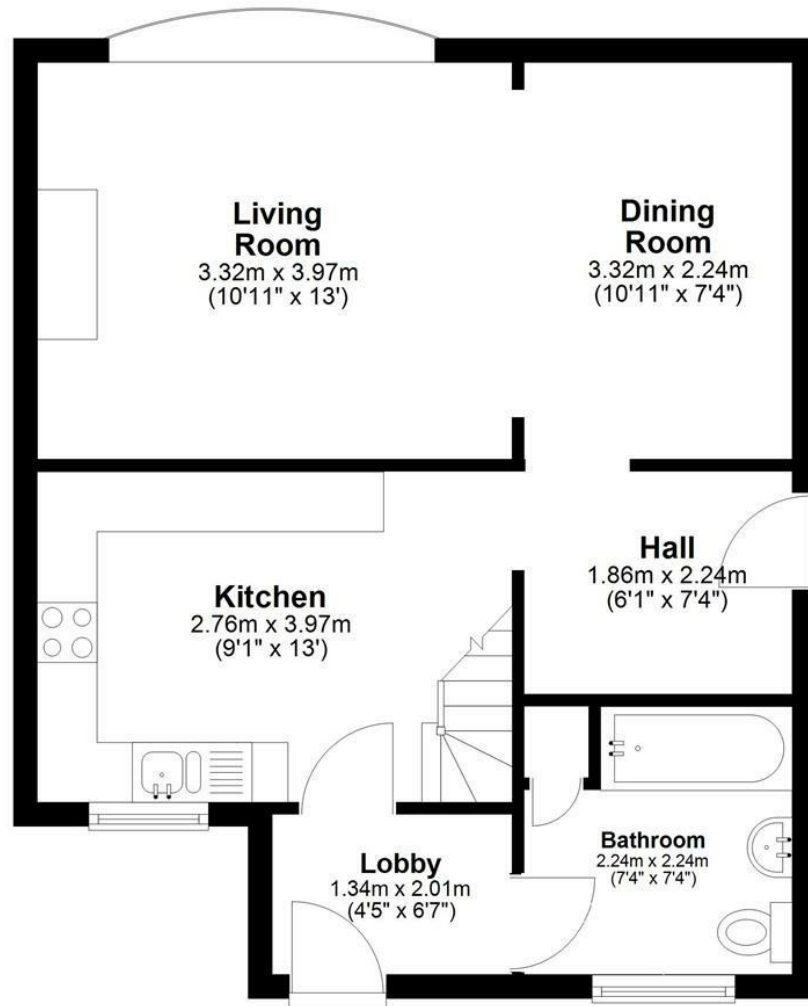

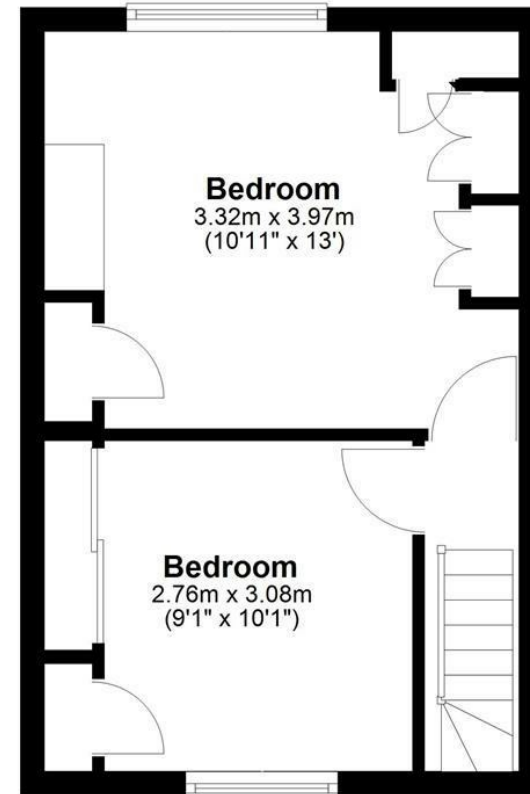


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Ground Floor
