

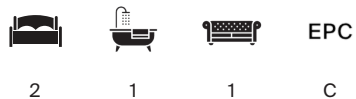


HARCOURT TERRACE,

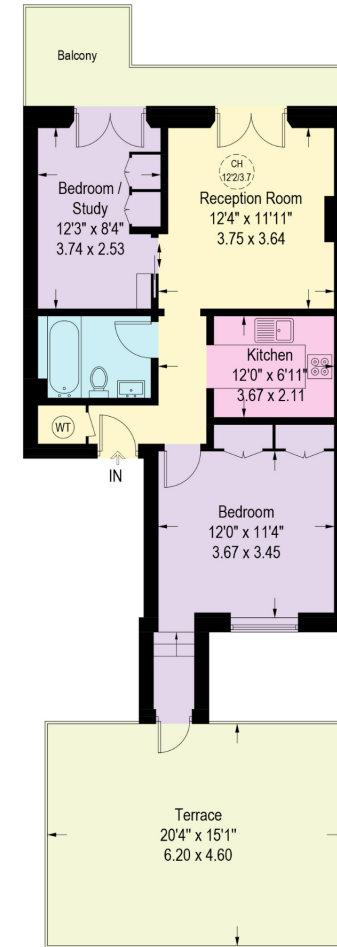

The reception space leads out onto the quaint north-eastern facing balcony space. The principal bedroom is fitted with built-in storage and is located just off the main corridor. The secondary bedroom, which could also be used as an office space, and an additional WC can be found on the opposite side of the hall. The kitchen is well-appointed and has a lovely wooden cabinetry finish.

Harcourt Terrace is quiet residential street, conveniently situated for accessing the superb shops, bars and restaurants on Fulham Road. The nearest underground station is Earls Court (Piccadilly and District lines) just 0.6 miles away for links to central London, the City and Heathrow. Pleasant walking and cycling routes can be enjoyed through Brompton Cemetery and along the Thames Path.
