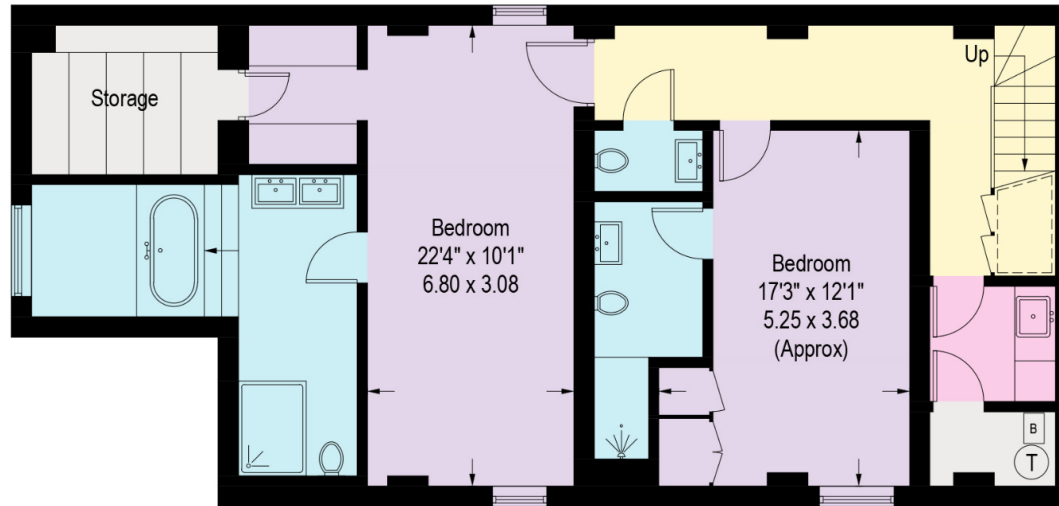

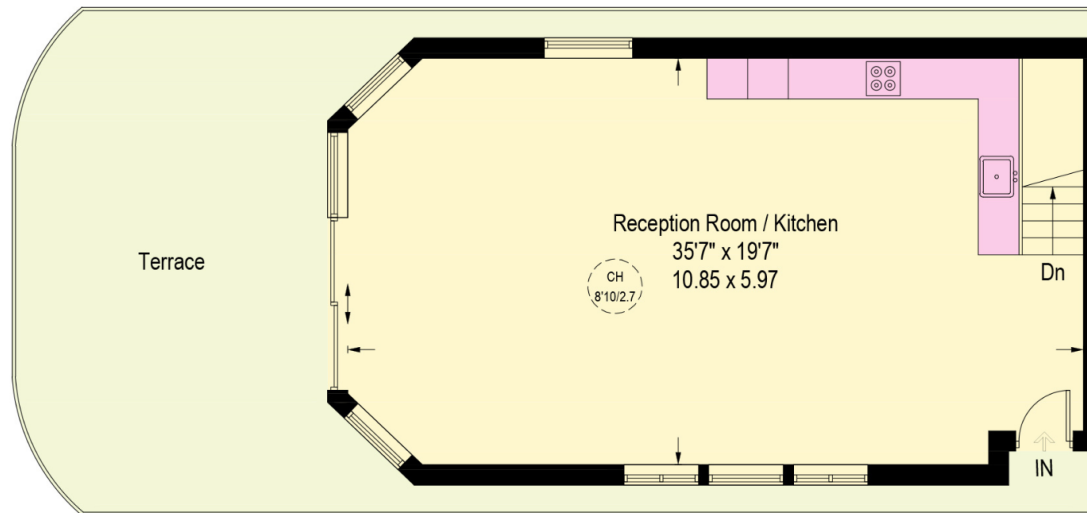








First Floor
