To the rear, the modern kitchen/diner is thoughtfully designed for both family living and entertaining, with ample space and a well fitted modern kitchen. This opens directly into a light-filled conservatory, perfect for enjoying views over the garden all year round.

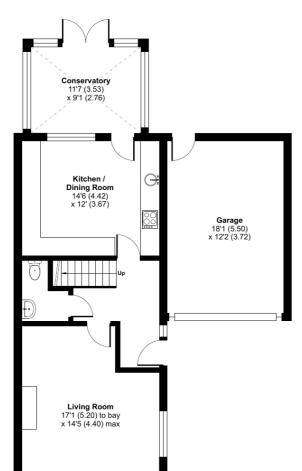
Closer to home the village has its own Primary School, village hall, sports and social club and falls in to the Sharnbrook Academy catchment.







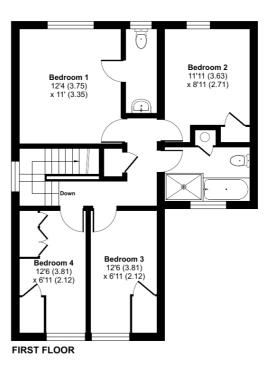
