



Description

Bickenhall Mansions has a rich history, building in 1869 and was once the home of the British Special Operations Executive, an arm of the intelligence services during World War II.

Originally based in Baker Street, the Special Operations
Executive grew to such an extent, that Winston Churchill took over Bickenhall Mansions, along with many other mansion blocks to provide space for the ever growing intelligence team.

Floorplan



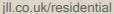
