Located in the beautiful rolling hills of Bedfordshire, but ideally placed for access to nearby big towns and further afield to London, Castlefield Park is perfectly positioned in the lovely village of Harlington.


Castlefield Park is under a mile from the nearest M1 junction giving easy access to Luton, Milton Keynes, and London. Harlington Station is just half a mile away and provides direct Thameslink access to London, while Luton Airport is less than a twenty minute drive away. There is a fine choice of primary and secondary schools nearby with a 'Good' Ofsted rating. There is also a well rated pre-school nursery in the village, while the nearby Harlington Upper School also includes a sixth-form college.

The Chesham (997sq foot) is a generously sized three bedroom property. Inspired by tradition, it has a double fronted layout and features an attractive bay window which, together with French doors, make this a beautifully bright property. A welcoming hallway leads to two spacious rooms: an open plan kitchen and dining area, along with a spacious living room. Upstairs, bedroom one benefits from an en suite shower room and a built-in wardrobe. There is an additional two bedrooms plus a family bathroom.
