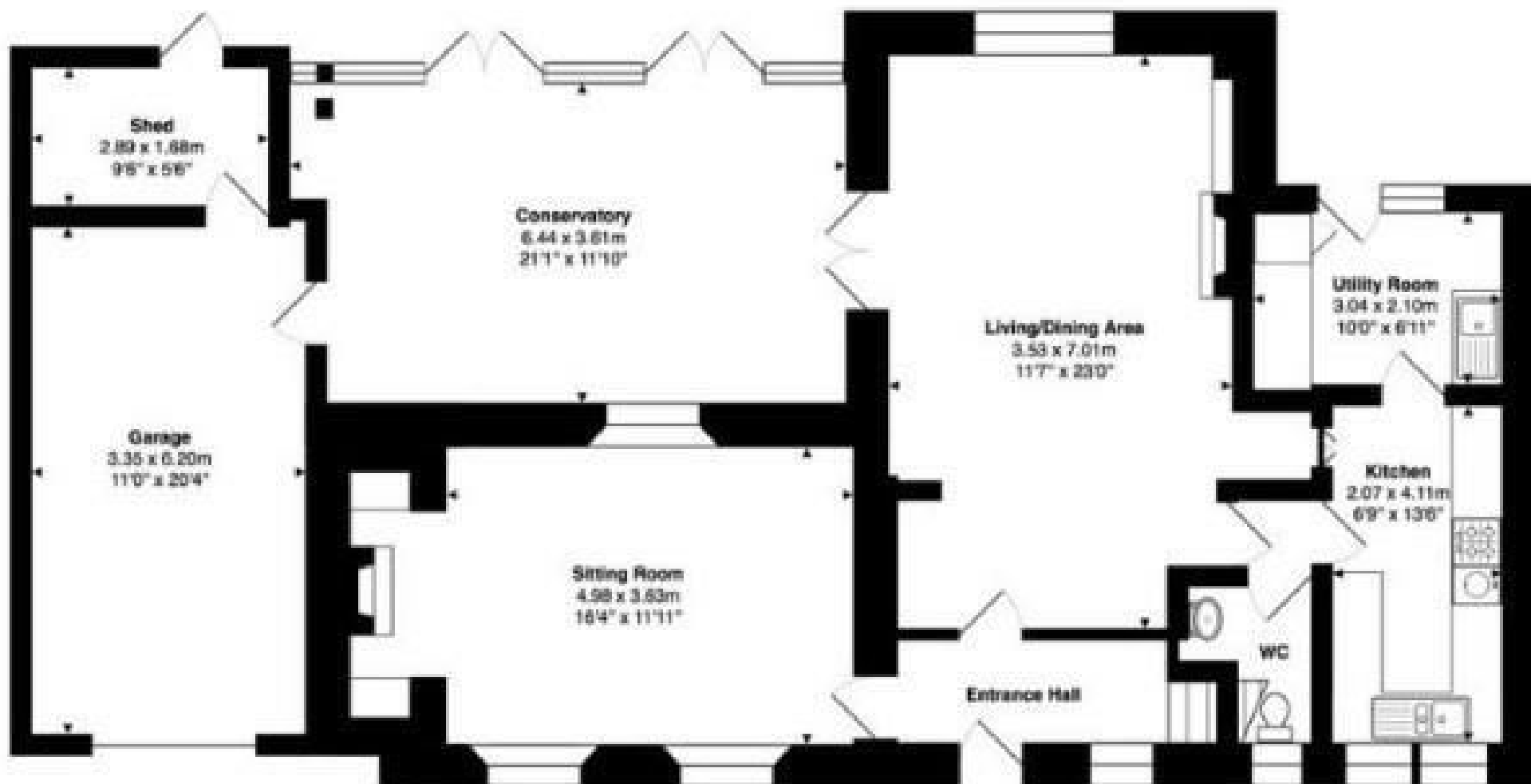






Ground Floor

The Property

A recently refurbished five-bedroom semi-detached cottage that blends modern comforts with charming character features. The property is set back from the road behind a pretty front garden, with a gated pathway leading to the front door. The home benefits from off-street parking for one vehicle, a garage, and additional parking is available on the road to the front.

Inside, the entrance hall leads into a warm and inviting living room. This room is full of character with its wood flooring, exposed beams, and a stunning open stone fireplace, perfect for cosy evenings. The two front-facing windows allow natural light to flood into the spacious room.

The kitchen, is well-appointed with a Stoves oven with 7-burner gas hob and space for a washing machine and dishwasher. A utility room with a sink and direct access to the rear garden adds to the functionality of this space. Additionally, to the rear of the property is a large dining room, ideal for family gatherings and entertaining and a spacious garden room provides a seamless transition to the outdoor area, with direct access to the garden and the garage. The ground floor also features a convenient WC.

Carpeted stairs lead to the first floor, where there are five well-proportioned bedrooms.

The principal bedroom boasts an ensuite shower room, while the family bathroom offers both a bath and a separate shower, with a separate WC for added convenience.

Outside

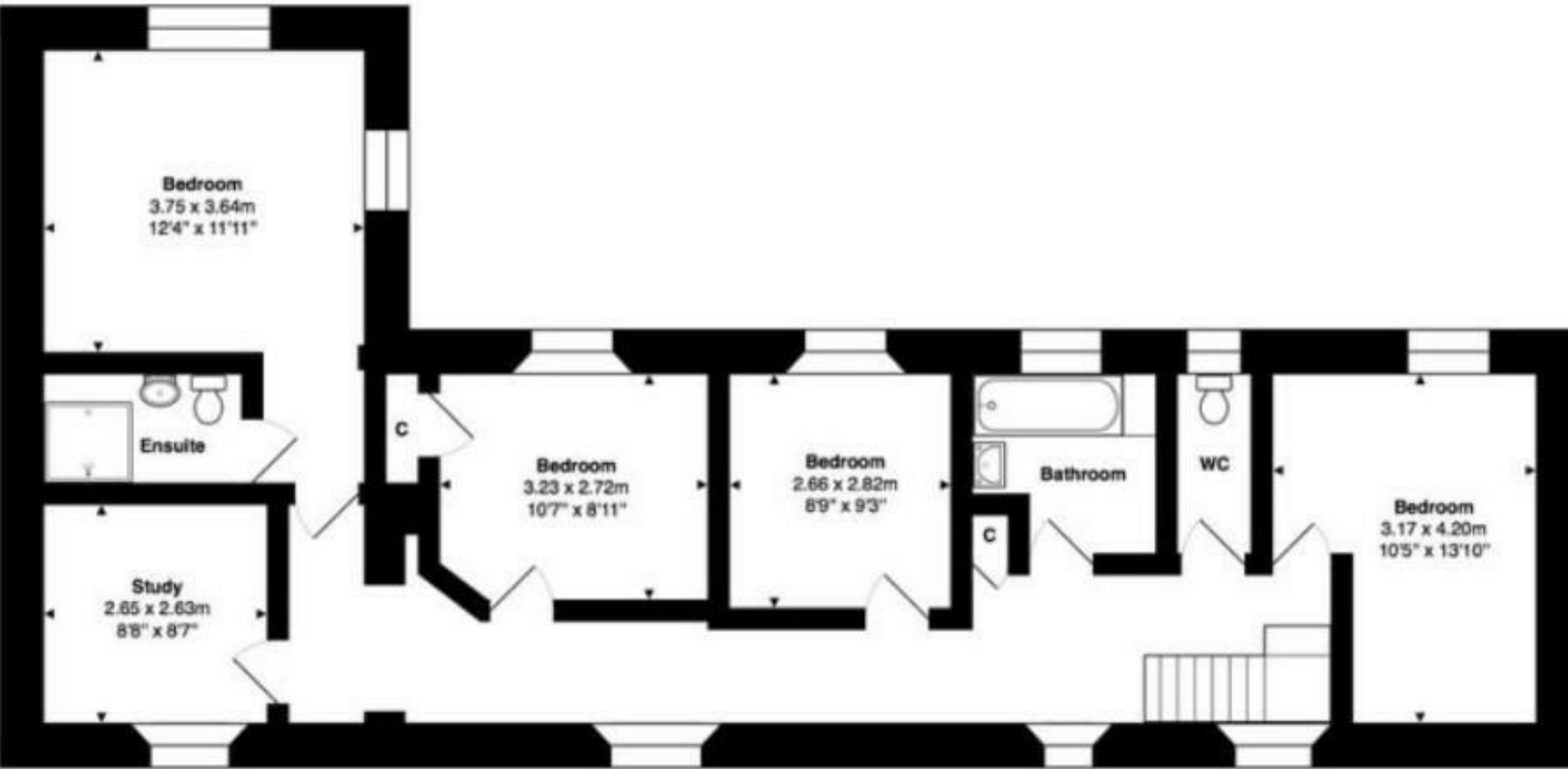

Situation

Finstock is a lovely Cotswold village, ideally placed in the heart of the Cotswolds, between Burford (9 miles) and Chipping Norton (9 miles). It has a highly regarded Primary School, a popular village pub (The Plough) and great countryside walks and bridleways all on your doorstep. The Market Town of Witney with supermarkets, shops, restaurants and cafés, is just 5 miles away. Charlbury Station (London Paddington 70 mins) is just 4 miles, Burford 9 miles, Woodstock 9 miles, Chipping Norton 9 miles, Estelle Manor 4 miles, Soho Farmhouse 11 miles, Daylesford Organic Farm Shop 12 miles, Oxford Parkway (London Marylebone 60 mins) 14 miles.
