Pipers Corner school is in the nearby Village of Prestwood, there is also access to the Aylesbury Grammar Schools and the secondary school in nearby Princes Risborough. Lacey Green has an Iconic Smock mill that dates to 1650 and is the oldest mill in England. The village also benefits from two Pubs, one being the Pink & Lily which is in the same Hamlet. There are several walks across the quintessential English countryside and lots of areas of woodland to explore. Transport links are from nearby Princes Risborough station:- London Marylebone can be reached in 50 minutes and the M40 junction is just 7.6 miles away, providing links to London the Midlands and the North.
