The modern fitted kitchen is home to an abundance of both cupboard and worktop units. Offered with an integral gas hob and electric oven, the kitchen has space for a washing machine and an under-counter fridge/freezer. Without doubt the hub of the apartment is the open plan living/dining area which, bathed in natural light, is perfect for entertainment and reception throughout all times of the day, given the wonderful aspect of the sea. Boasting versatile dimensions, the open-plan accommodation allows for all desired contents and furnishings. The principal bedroom within the apartment is a spacious double room which, again, benefits from a coastal aspect. The second bedroom is a box room which could be utilised perfectly as an office/study for those working from home. Complementing the bedrooms is the family bathroom comprising a shower over bath, wash basin, WC, wall mounted cupboard and a heated towel rail. Founded in 1846 by Henry Le Strange as a Victorian Gothic bathing resort, Hunstanton thrived with the railway from King's Lynn, becoming a top day-trip destination. Today, holidaymakers flock to Searles Leisure Resort, enjoy boat trips on the Wash Monster, fairground rides, and traditional arcades.

Facing west across The Wash, "Sunny Hunny" is famous for its sunsets. Summer evenings are perfect for watching the sun set from the green, beach, or Victorian squares. Impressive Victorian and Edwardian properties line these squares, alongside contemporary homes, apartments, and senior living accommodations. Education options include a primary and secondary school (Smithdon High, a Grade II listed building), and Glebe House School, a co-educational prep school. Amenities feature a GP surgery, post office, leisure pool, and gym at The Oasis, overlooking the sea. Local shopping includes Tesco, Sainsbury's, and a Lidl nearby in Heacham, along with a fantastic local greengrocer and award-winning deli. Dining options range from full English breakfasts to afternoon tea at Berni Beans and relaxing at wine bar Chives.
