Upon arrival to the cottage, prospective tenants are immediately welcomed in to the cosy sitting room. Boasting versatile dimensions for all traditional furnishings, the sitting room is perfect for relaxing amongst the upcoming Autumnal months. Beyond the sitting room, the newly installed modern fitted kitchen, home to an abundance of both cupboard and worktop units is ideal for those looking to display their culinary skills. Offered with an integral electric oven/hob, the kitchen has space for a fridge freezer. Separate from the kitchen, prospective tenants will find a utility room which offers space for a washing machine. Completing the ground floor accommodation is a cloakroom comprising a shower, wash basin, WC and a heated towel rail.

Stairs located in the sitting room lead prospective tenants to the first floor bedroom and bathroom accommodation.

The principal bedroom is an extensive double with ample space for all desired furnishings. The second bedroom, a smaller double room again enjoys an aspect out over the private enclosed garden and could be utilised as an office/study for those working remotely. Complimenting the bedrooms is a dual accessible bathroom featuring a bath tub, wash basin and WC.

Externally, the property benefits from ample on street parking to the front. The private rear enclosed garden features a low maintenance lawn, a patio area and a brick built outhouse with electric supply.
