MARLBOROUGH

The Parade is a square of character buildings located off the main roads and close to the centre of Marlborough, offering easy access in to town and to the countryside. Marlborough is a thriving, market town situated within an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The town offers excellent local independent shops, an independent cinema, some of the major retailers and supermarkets (including Waitrose) and boasts a number of good quality restaurants such as Rick Steins and Dan's. The Leisure Centre and Golf Club provide excellent sporting facilities, while there are also good schools within the town including St. Johns Academy.

The town is surrounded by the most attractive countryside of the Marlborough Downs, Savernake Forest, Pewsey Vale and Kennet Valley. The M4 gives access to London and the West Country.













THE PROPERTY

9 The Parade is a characterful Grade II listed and stylishly presented home in the heart of Marlborough. The house is arranged over two floors with character throughout. Of particular note is the sitting room which has an exposed brick fireplace fitted with a contemporary gas stove and off which there is an extremely useful study area.

The modern kitchen has double doors to the garden and is fitted with a range of wall and floor mounted units with wooden worktops. The kitchen has space for a range type cooker and fridge freezer and has a fitted dishwasher. The kitchen is open plan to the dining area providing a great space for entertaining. There is also a combined cloakroom/ utility adjacent to the rear hallway which offers further access to the garden.

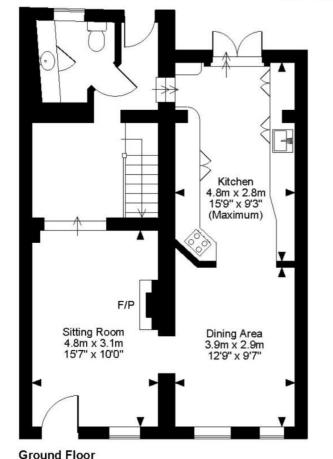
Stairs from the study area lead to the first floor bedrooms, which include two large double bedrooms with a lovely outlook over The Parade, with a further large single bedroom. To the rear. The main bedroom has a modern en suite shower room and there is also a well appointed family bathroom.

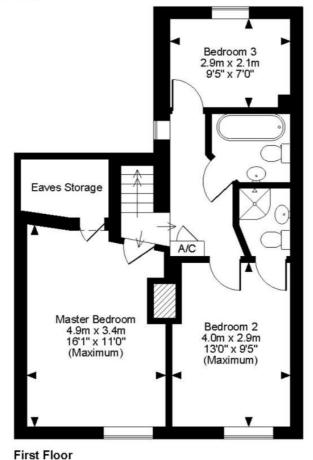
OUTSIDE

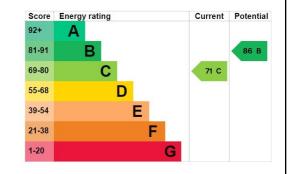
