Plot 180 comes with two parking spaces and a rear garden. Some properties within the development may have an EV charging point and solar panels.

Heatherwood Royal is a brand new development at the top of Ascot High Street, built by Taylor Wimpey. Popular local schools include Charters, Cheapside, Lambrook, LVS, The Marist, Papplewick, St Francis, St George's and St Mary's. Ascot train station runs services to London, Reading and Guildford and by road Ascot is convenient for the M3, M4, M25 and Heathrow Airport.
