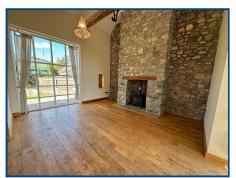

Property Description

The barn has been tastefully converted to provide an ideal family home in scenic surroundings. Of stone construction under a slated roof incorporating many attractive features including under floor oil heating, oak kitchen with marble work surfaces, oak skirtings, oak flooring, panelled doors, double glazing, large patio doors, arrow slit windows and stone fireplace with timber beam and wood burning stove. VIEWING IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED.

The property stands just over 3 miles from Llandeilo town which offers a wide range of amenities including a range of individual shops and places of recreation, schools and sports clubs. The closer village of Ffairfach has primary and secondary schooling, station on the heart of Wales railway and two village pubs. Convenient to Ammanford, Cross Hands and the M4 Motorway at Pont Abraham which gives easy access to the rest of the country.

The accommodation comprises entrance hall, cloakroom, utility room, study/bedroom, kitchen/ dining area and lounge on the ground floor, 3 bedrooms, ensuite and family bathroom at first floor. Externally there is a rear garden with paved patio and front garden area.

With stainless steel sink unit with mixer tap, fitted cupboards and worktop, plumbing for washing machine, double glazed window. Grant oil fired central heating boiler, extractor fan and tiled floor.

Kitchen / Breakfast Room (19' 3" x 18' 2") or (5.87m x 5.53m)

With a range of wall, larder, base and drawer units with marble worktops. Belfast sink with mixer tap, 4 ring gas hob and electric oven with stainless steel extractor fan. Tiled floor, double glazed window and stable door to rear. Arrow slit window with spot light. Tiled floor and down lights.

Lounge (16' 10" x 15' 11") or (5.14m x 4.84m)

With double doors from the kitchen area, large picture window and patio doors to the front. Feature slit window, TV point and telephone point. Oak flooring, feature stone fireplace with woodburning stove and hearth. High ceiling with exposed beam.

With oak flooring, double glazed window, telephone point and TV point.
