A charming country cottage standing in grounds of just under a third of an acre with panoramic views of the surrounding area. Set in the village of Derwydd in a convenient location.

The property does require modernisation and update with much potential for extending, built of traditional construction under a slated roof with front stone elevation, retaining many original features to include the original windows, french doors, quarry tiled floor and fireplaces.

Situated in a popular location between Llandeilo and Ammanford towns which offer a wide and varied range of amenities to include a bank, shops, offices and schools. Llandybie is within 2 miles with primary school and local amenities and the M4 Motorway junction at Pont Abraham is within easy commuting distance and gives good road links to the rest of the country.

The area is a well known tourist destination with popular attractions of Dinefwr, Carreg Cennen and Dryslwyn Castles, Aberglasney Gardens and The Botanical Gardens of Wales are all within a short drive away.

The accommodation comprise side entrance door to snug/porch area, shower room, kitchen/dining/living area, lounge, 3 bedrooms and bathroom.

Entrance

Double glazed door to:

Front Porch/Snug

Roof light. Double glazed window, timber surround and panelled ceiling.

Shower Room (7' 6" x 5' 0") or (2.29m x 1.52m)

With pedestal wash hand basin, low level wc and large walk in shower with sliding doors and shower unit. Heated towel rail, double glazed windows, respatex walls and built in shelving. Extractor fan, electric heater and panelled ceiling.

With bay incorporating double glazed windows and french doors. Feature open fireplace with timber surround and tiled hearth. Picture rail and built in cupboard and shelving. 2 electric heaters. Range of base and drawer units with shelving, fitted worktops and stainless steel sink unit with mixer tap. Plumbing for washing machine, respetex walls, appliance space, part panelled ceiling and under stairs cupboard.

With quarry tiled floor, dado rail, side door and window. Stairs for first floor.

Quarry tiled floor, tiled open fireplace with mantle and hearth, window to front and built in cupboards.

Window, dado rail and access to roof space.

Pedestal wash hand basin and low level WC. Pull switch and window with scenic views.

Bedroom 1 (11' 3" Max x 7' 1") or (3.43m Max x 2.17m)

Sash window with views to front. Pull switch.

Bedroom 2 (12' 11" x 8' 10") or (3.93m x 2.68m)

Window to front. Pull switch.

Bedroom 3 (10' 9" x 8' 10") or (3.27m x 2.70m)

Pull switch and sash window to rear.

The property is approached via double entrance gates to ample parking and turning area with pedestrian gate to a graveled area with concrete paths.
