Rolled edge work surfaces with inset stainless steel sink unit with chrome mixer tap and tiled splash back. Built-in electric oven and hob with stainless steel extractor over. Open fronted shelving. Under stairs recess with space for fridge/freezer and useful storage cupboard. Stairs to first floor. Slate tiled floor. Doorway to:

Two double glazed windows to front with window seats. Radiator. Feature open fireplace with stone surround and hearth. Three wall light points. Coving.

Double glazed window to front with window seat. Radiator. Exposed stone wall with fireplace. Under stairs cupboard housing gas fired combination boiler.

Bathroom

Obscure double glazed window to side. Chrome ladder radiator. Feature small internal stained glass window. Free standing roll top bath with chrome mixer tap and shower attachment. Vanity wash basin with cupboard under. Close coupled WC with concealed cistern. Utility cupboard housing washing machine and with space for tumble drier. Spotlights.

Opening into:

Bedroom Two

Double glazed window to side and rear. Radiator. Fitted cupboards and drawer unit.

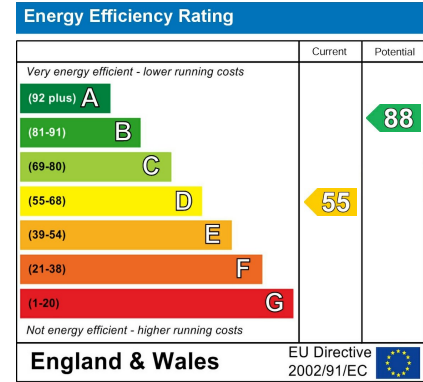
Outside

Directions

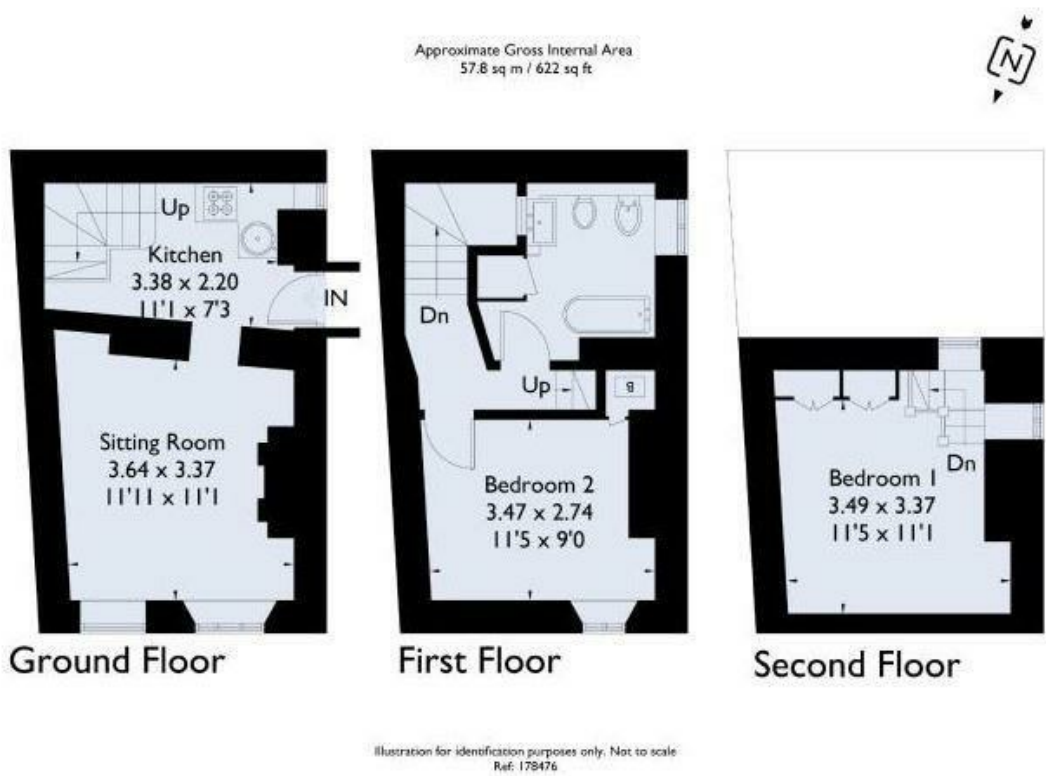
