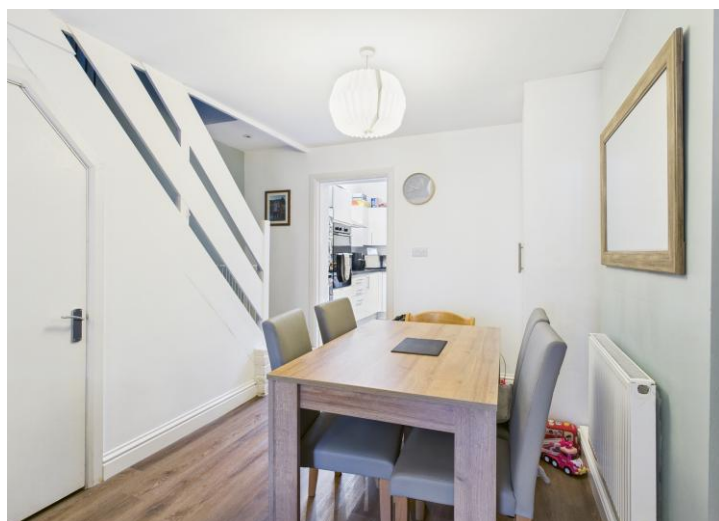


## THE PROPERTY
