Balfron is in the heart of Stirlingshire and equidistant between Killearn and Drymen. 17 miles west of Stirling, surrounded by the delightful villages of Kippen, Fintry, Killearn and Drymen and the gentle rolling countryside known as The Campsie Fells. These local villages service the well renowned local High School of Balfron and provide an easy and convenient bus route to the City Centres of Glasgow and Stirling.

Within easy reach of Glasgow, being only 17 miles away, The Trossachs and Loch Katrine, and particularly handy for Loch Lomond which features Lomond Shores Visitor Centre, the National Park for nature walks and cycling as well as boat trips and fishing on the Loch. The West Highland Way crosses nearby at Drymen so this is also an ideal area for walkers.

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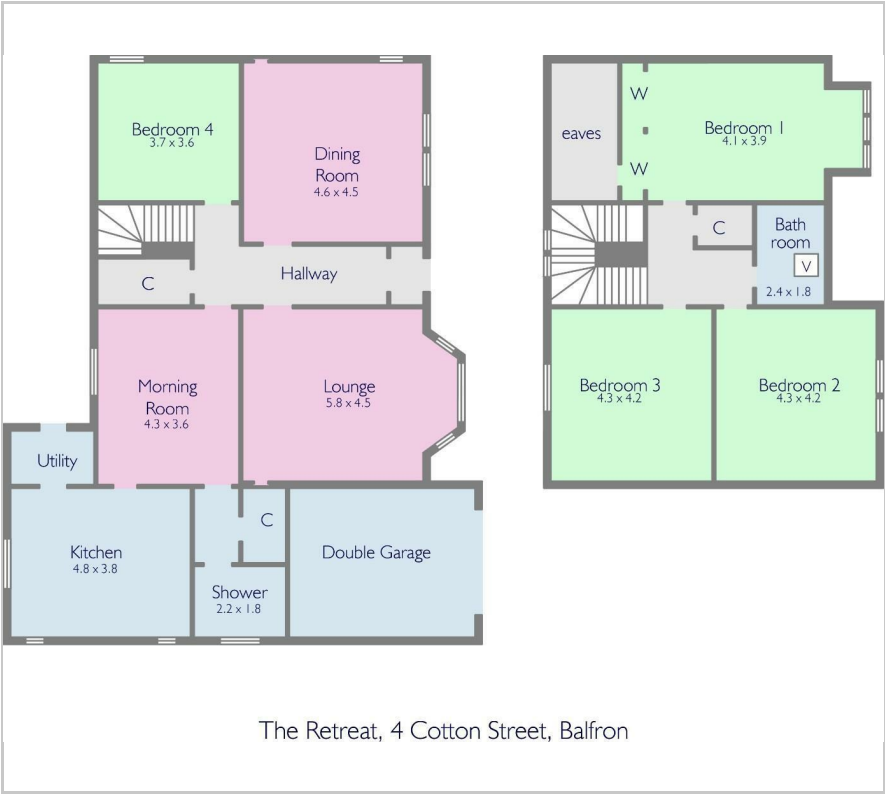


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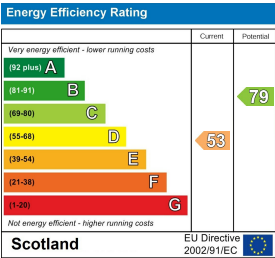
Floor Plan
