
You will find a host of coffee shops, pubs and restaurants in the town centre in which to relax and unwinc along with a cinema, theatre, art gallery and museum.



There are several infant & primary schools within the area including Long Lawford Primary, Henry Hinde Infant and Henry Hinde Junior School, all of which are only a short drive away.

The Bilton School is the main Secondary and Sixth form in the area, The Avon Valley School & Performing Arts College is approximately 5 minutes to the East of Long Lawford, all of which have been rated "Good" by Ofsted.

For further education, just a short drive in to Rugby Town Centre you will find Rugby College (Part of WCG) specialising in Engineering, Advanced Machining and Robotics. The college also offers a diverse range of courses with superb facilities to suit all.


This fascinating Art Gallery and Museum, located in the centre of Rugby offers a range of interesting exhibitions, events and activities for all ages.



Our variation of characterful double glazed windows use modern technology to ensure heat loss is kept to a minimum.








