GROUND FLOOR

ENTRANCE

Upon entry in to the property through the side door there are stairs which rise to the first floor landing.

LOUNGE

The living room has front and side facing UPVC double glazed windows and a front facing UPVC door. The focal point of the room is the log burner.

DINING KITCHEN

The kitchen has rear and side facing UPVC double glazed windows, radiator, wall and base units with complementary worktop and integrated sink. There is also access to the downstairs basement.

CELLAR

The basement is split into two parts, half of the basement has a rear facing UPVC double glazed window and a rear facing door to access the garden. It has one radiator and a storage cupboard underneath the stairs.

To the front of the property is a buffer garden and to the rear is a much larger than expected, enclosed and well stocked garden with a lovely, secluded seating area.


Area Map
