








FLOOR PLAN, DIMENSIONS & MAP

Ground Floor







THE LOCATION

Surrounded by stunning countryside, Melrose is a picturesque town widely regarded as the Jewel of the Scottish Borders. It's home to the world-renowned Rugby Sevens tournament first played here in 1883. You can enjoy an abundance of leisure activities and sports in Melrose including tennis, horse riding, golf, and lovely walks, as well as partake in a spot of private fishing on the world-famous Bowden reservoir. This is a town that really takes pride in its appearance – evident from the abundance of unique, quality and independent shops located around half a mile walk from Fairways.







Melrose Abbey is a popular visitor attraction which is maintained by Historic Scotland and is one of many fascinating places of historic interest in the town. Melrose is a quality location that offers you culture, charm and places of outstanding natural beauty on your doorstep. The town is home to St Marys private school, Melrose Primary School and Nursery along with Earlston High School which is a short drive away and is one of the highest regarded secondary schools within the Scottish Borders.

The Borders Railway line is due to be up and running by September 2015 with half-hourly services at peak times over seven days of the week. The rail line will run from Tweedbank in the Scottish Borders to Midlothian, Edinburgh Waverley, connecting to the national and international rail network within an hour. The rail line is roughly 3/4s of a mile from the development. Edinburgh is 39 miles, Galashiels 4 miles and the Borders General Hospital is roughly a 2-minute drive from the property.
