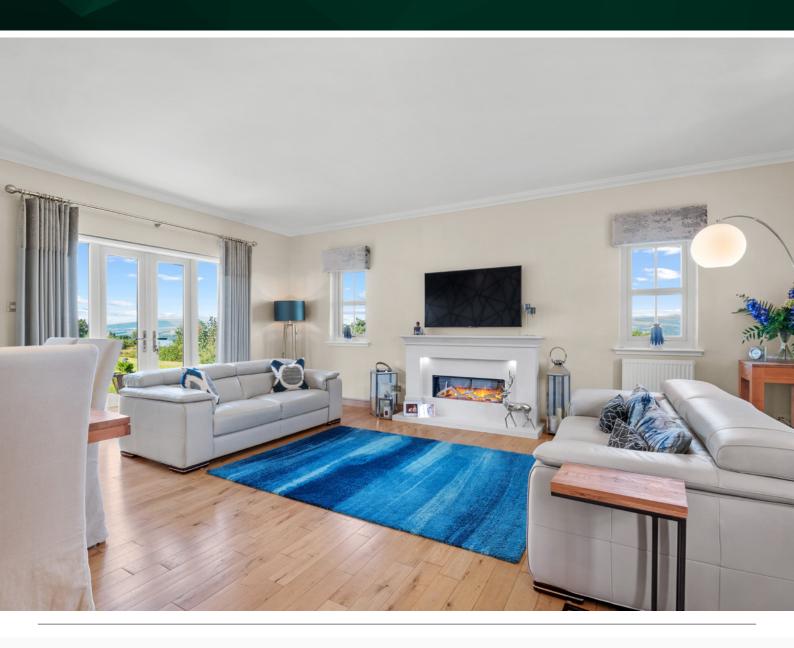

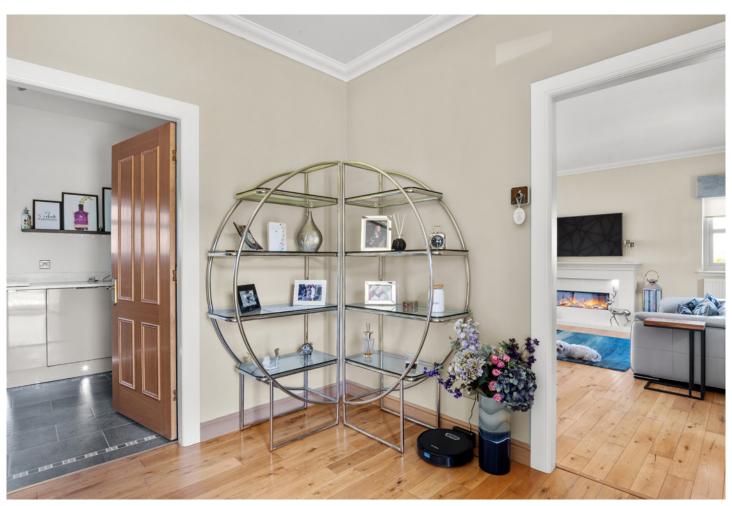

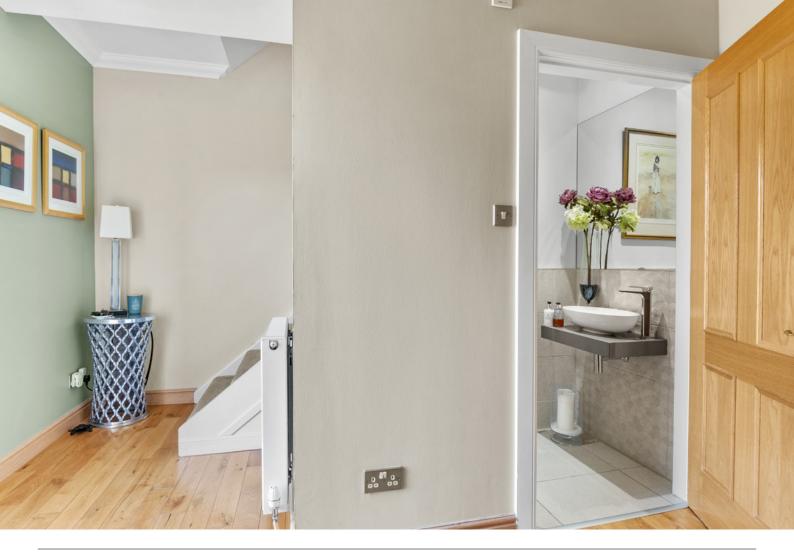
The luxury downstairs cloakroom completes the accommodation on this level.

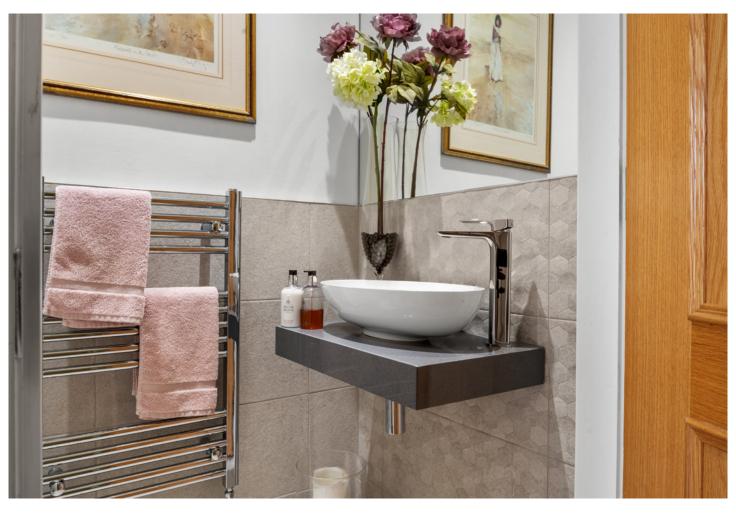












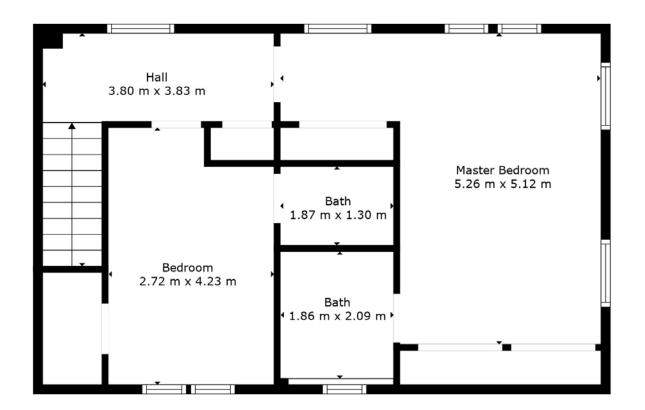

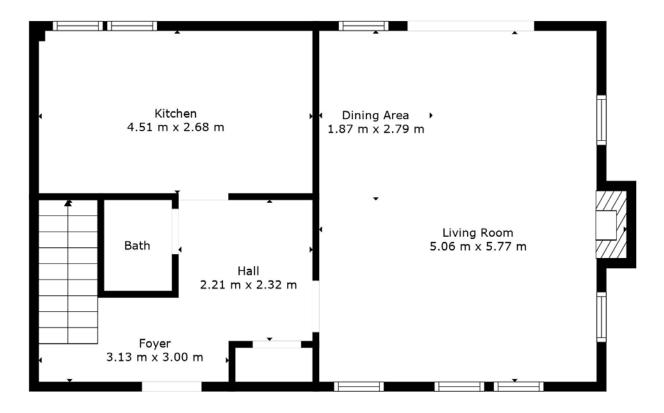








Floor 2

The property has gas central heating and double glazing, helping to ensure a warm, costeffective living environment all year round.





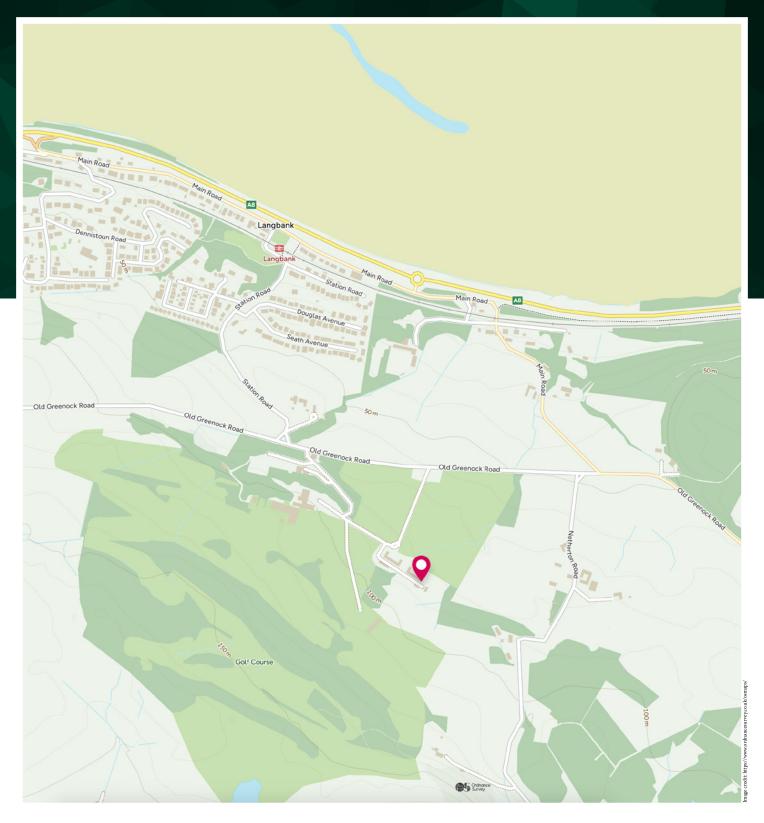
