THE LIVING ROOM



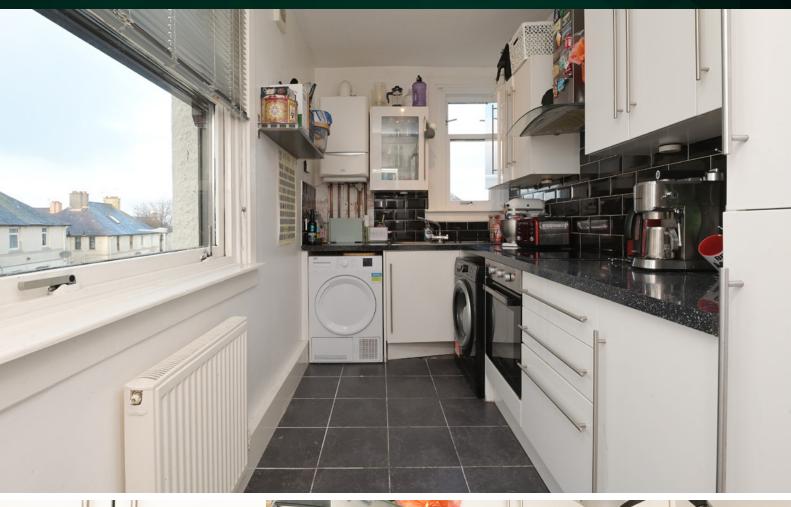

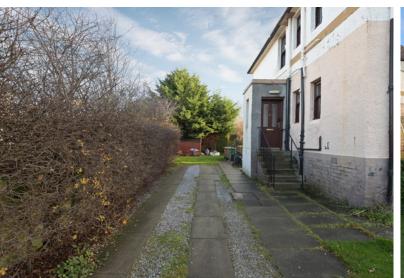




Externally, there is a private garden to the side and rear, and a driveway providing off-street parking.

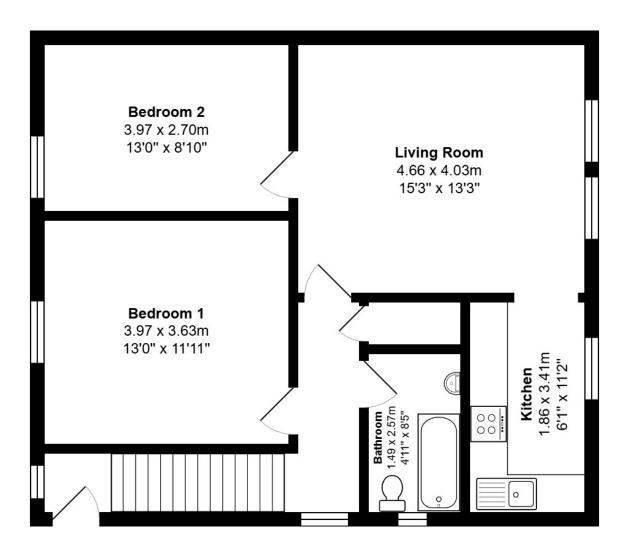

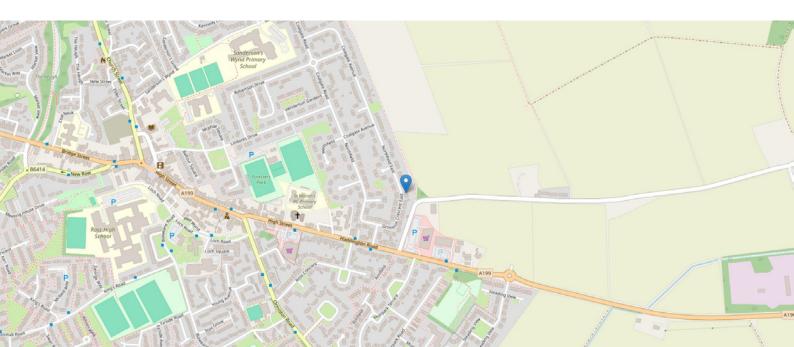


FLOOR PLAN & DIMENSIONS
