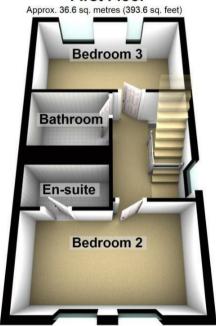

# PROPERTY FLOORPLAN

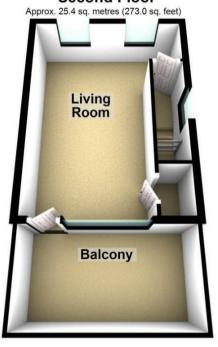
### Ground Floor

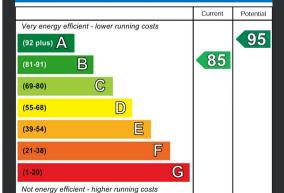
