London Paddington is less than 30 minutes from Reading Railway Station or 45 minutes from Goring Railway Station (3 miles away). Crossrail, two Elizabeth Line trains an hour, will allow passengers to travel right through central London from Reading station without having to change trains. Woodcote is within a designated Area Of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB).

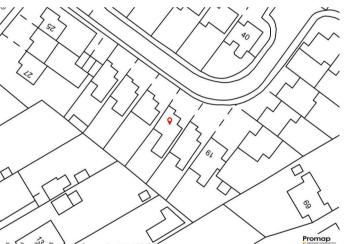




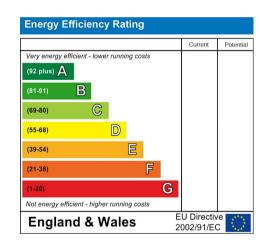












## **Directions**
