### **Entrance Porch**

The front door opens to an entrance porch, door to sitting room.

## **Sitting Room**

14'1 x 31'1

The sitting room is a charming room full of character, with brick inglenook fireplace, beams and window to the front aspect, door to kitchen, dining room.

## **Dining Room**

14'1 x 14'1

A superb spacious entertaining space with double doors to the rear garden, a stone tiled floor flows through to the kitchen.

### **Kitchen**

9'10 x 9'2

The kitchen is fitted with a comprehensive range of wall and base units with granite worksurfaces, butlers sink with taps over, space and plumbing for washing machine and dishwasher, window overlooking the rear garden.

#### **First Floor**

The stairs lead from the dining room to the first floor landing.



### **Bedroom One**

14'1 x 9'10

A bright and airy room with windows to the front aspect, wooden floor, built in cupboard. This room could be remodelled to become two separate single bedrooms if required.

### **Bedroom Two**

12'2 x 9'2

Used as the master bedroom, bedroom two is another light and spacious double bedroom, built in wardrobes,

wooden floor and a large window overlooking the rear garden.

### **Shower Room**

8'10 x 7'3

A white suite comprising of walk in shower, low level wc and wash hand basin.



#### Outside

The rear garden is a real feature of this delightful cottage, well stocked borders edge a large area of lawn accessed from a generous paved terrace to the rear of the cottage. The garden is fully enclosed by panelled fencing. In addition there is a spacious summer house / home office with power, light and telephone line.

To the front of the cottage is parking for one vehicle, there is on road parking for any additional vehicles.

#### Location

Situated in an attractive row of terraced cottages in the small hamlet of Terrick close to Wendover with its eclectic mix of shops, pubs and restaurants and ever popular schools, together with the mainline station offering a frequent service to Marylebone (45mins). The A41 can be found between Aston Clinton and Tring, offering a swift connection to the M25. Alternatively the M40 can be found at High Wycombe.

#### **Education**


