The turning for White House Barns is situated off Ashfield Road, shortly before leaving the village and just before the new Ashfield Park development.





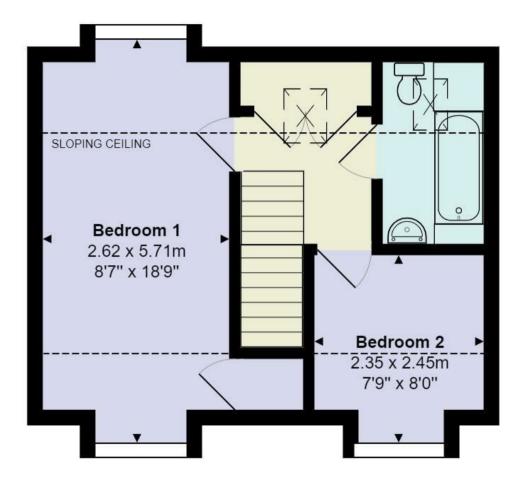
