



Location

The town of Bourne has a population of approximately 15,000 and is situated in the heart of south Lincolnshire, close to the towns of Market Deeping, Spalding, and Stamford, and approximately 16 miles from the city of Peterborough. The Burghley Centre is the town's main Shopping Centre located in a busy and popular retail location with an excellent level of footfall.

The scheme is anchored by a 12,285 sq ft M&S Simply Food and adjoins the town's main car park with approximately 160 car parking spaces. Occupiers within the Burghley Centre include **Costa, Specsavers** and **Yorkshire Trading Company**. Other national occupiers elsewhere in the town include **Boots, Superdrug, Heron, Nationwide** and **Card Factory** amongst others.

Description

The unit is arranged over ground floor benefiting from a prominent position and return frontage at the entrance to the Burghley Centre fronting North Street.

Accommodation

The property is arranged over ground floor with an approximate total net internal area of 1,480 sq ft (137.5 sq m).

Tenure & Terms

The property is available by way of a new effectively full repairing and insuring lease for a term to be agreed. All rents and service charges are subject to VAT at the prevailing rates.

Each party is to be responsible for their own legal costs incurred in the transaction.

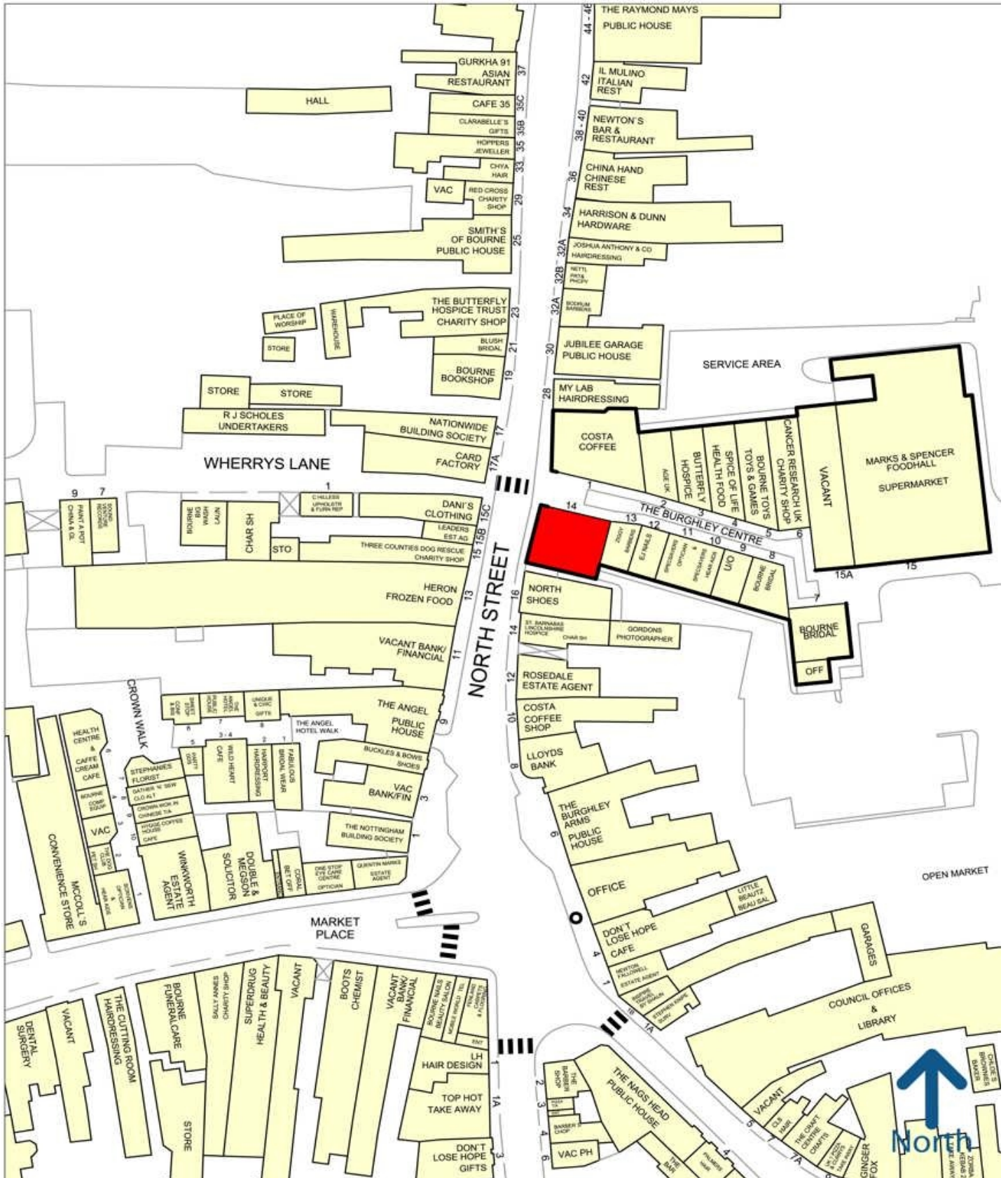
