




Amenities

You're spoilt for choice when it comes to local schools, and nearby Rugby has all the shops, restaurants, and other amenities you could need. The town has a variety of traditional pubs, so in your down time grab a drink, do some shopping or immerse yourself in local culture at the town's museums. Further afield there's even more to explore; Warwick and Leamington Spa are roughly 30 minutes' drive away, and they're perfect for day trips with the family.

Schools



Cawston Grange Primary School (0.3 miles)
A welcoming school that's roughly

5 minutes' walk from the development.

Bilton School (0.5 miles)

A co-educational secondary school within walking distance of the development, catering for children from 11 to 18 years old.

Henry Hinde Infant School (0.6 miles)

Teaching children aged 4 to 7, Henry Hinde is within easy walking distance of the development in Bilton.

Henry Hinde Junior School (0.7 miles)

This school caters for children from 7 to 11 years old, and is part of the NET Academies Warwickshire Cluster with Keresley Newland Primary Academy.

Bilton Infant School (0.9 miles)

Located close by in Bilton, this infant school teaches children in Reception, Year 1, and Year 2.

Crescent School (1.7 miles)

The only independent primary school in Rugby, teaching children aged 4 to 11 years old.

Rugby High School for Girls (2.1 miles)

This girls' grammar school is partnered with Lawrence Sheriff School, and is only a quick drive from the development.

Rugby School (2.6 miles)

Rugby High School is one of the oldest, and most prestigious, public schools in the country, teaching both boys and girls up to age 18.

Harris Church of England Academy

(2.8 miles)

A co-education secondary school driven by Christian values and catering for children up to 16 years of age.

Brooke School (2.5 miles)

Brooke is a specialist primary and secondary school for children with additional needs.

Lawrence Sheriff School (3.3 miles)

A boys' grammar school situated just a short bus or car journey away in Rugby.

University of Warwick (12.6 miles)

Situated in Coventry, roughly 20 minutes' drive from the development, the University of Warwick is consistently ranked among the top ten universities in the UK.

GPs and health services

It's easy to keep your family's health in check at Cawston Rise. There are multiple medical and dental practices in Rugby, as well as a GP within a mile of the development. For emergencies, the Hospital of St Cross is just 10 minutes away, and it's a short 20-minute drive to University Hospital Coventry.

Fitness

Over in Rugby, the state-of-the-art Queen's Diamond Jubilee Centre has everything you could need to keep fit — and it's right next to Rugby & Northampton Athletics Club and an indoor bowls club. You'll also find everything from gyms to yoga clubs spread in and around town.

Parks

Love the outdoors? Both Draycote Water and Daventry Country
Park are around 15 to 20 minutes' drive away, and there are several
National Trust parks in the local area. Closer to home there are
some beautiful walks in and around Cawston; explore the nearby
bluebell woods, or follow the path of the old railway line.

Transport

From Cawston Rise you have easy access to the M1 and M6, and the nearest train station in Rugby has regular services to London Euston (50 minutes), Birmingham New Street (30 minutes), and Leicester (1 hour).

Food and drink

Rugby town centre has a good range of traditional pubs, independent bars and restaurants, while at the monthly farmers' market you'll find the best and freshest local produce. Head into Warwick or Leamington Spa, each about half an hour's drive away, for even more choice.

Shopping

Local boutiques, independent retailers and supermarkets ensure you never have to travel far to find what you're looking for, while the town's Elliot's Field and Clock Towers shopping centres house the main high street stores.

After the builder warranty has ended, your home will continue to be protected by our insurance cover until 10 years after completion.


The national survey polls owners of new homes on everything from the buying and handover process to the design and layout of their property. They're also asked whether they'd recommend their builder to friends.
