## Ben Jonson House, Barbican, EC2Y

Ben Jonson House was named after the actor and playwright who wrote Bartholomew Fair and lived for some years in the parish of Cripplegate. Ben Jonson is the only person buried in an upright position in Westminster Abbey.

Residents benefit from: use of communal gardens, parking and storage below the building available to rent from the Corporation of London, refuse collection from your door and background heating included in your service charge.

Transport links are good with both Barbican, Moorgate and Farringdon close by, with access to the Elizabeth line, Circle and District lines.


