

New aluminium frame double glazed windows were added in keeping with the original style, engineered oak flooring was used throughout (except bedrooms and bathrooms), the kitchens were fitted with soft close drawers, under pelmet lighting to the wall units, Siemens appliances, an induction hob, fridge/freezer, dishwasher and microwave. The building is also wired for Gigabit Internet.
