Set within a conservation area in the heart of the City of London, the views look directly onto St. Bartholomew the Great Church, London's oldest surviving church.

The Museum of London will open in 2026, expecting to attract over one million visitors annually, the 900 year old Smithfield meat market will be also relocating from 2028.

Within walking distance are a number of excellent restaurants in Clerkenwell and the City, along with five star hotels which include The Ned, Malmaison, South Place Hotel and Vintry and Mercer.

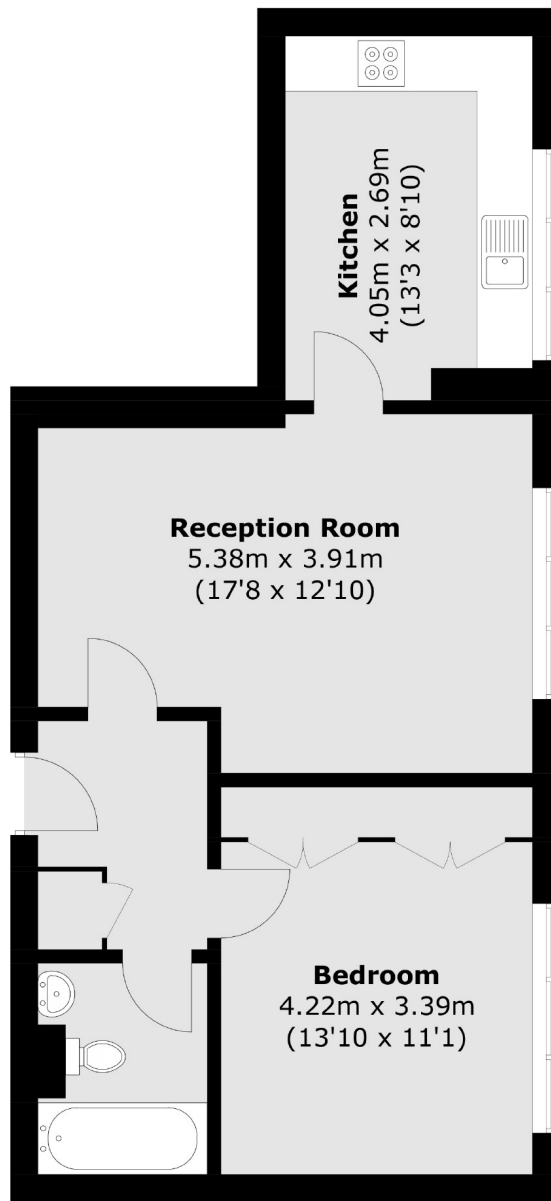
