



The Goathouse is a distinctive midcentury residence, designed by architect Kenneth Steel in the late 1960s. Set within a generous third of an acre plot, the property has been extensively renovated, blending contemporary finishes with a stylish retro aesthetic. Surrounded by a mature plantsman's garden, the home offers privacy and tranquillity.

Goathouse is situated in the village of West Hatch, a vibrant local community with pub, church, village hall and a range of activities on offer approximately 6 miles to the South East of Taunton, the County Town of Somerset. The Herepath (a circular 13 mile bridleway/footpath that crosses the Blackdown Hills) passes close to Goathouse and the Somerset Levels offer many opportunities for walking within 3 miles.

The popular village of Hatch Beauchamp is within 2.9 miles with amenities including community shop, village pub, restaurant, primary school and recreational ground.

Taunton is a bustling, forward-looking town with excellent amenities, a good selection of independent and high street shops, distinctive restaurants, cafés, a wealth of history and sporting facilities including the County Cricket Ground. Taunton benefits from a main line railway station linking to London Paddington in less than 2 hours and excellent communications for the M5 motorway at Junction 25 less than a mile away.




