Pendell Court Farm House

A truly lovely family house with parts dating back to the 17th century (not listed). The house is to be found down a charming country track within a short walk of The Hawthorns School and surrounded by bridleways, footpaths and cycle paths.

The rooms which are arranged on three floors are large and well-proportioned with a fabulous family kitchen/breakfast room/conservatory leading directly to a rear walled garden. The second floor contains a separate one-bedroom apartment with its own kitchen/breakfast room, bathroom and sitting room leading onto a roof terrace. Outside there are two additional stone outbuildings including a small barn currently used as a craft workshop. Landscaped walled gardens provide several areas for seating and outdoor entertainment and include two ponds and a rill. Parking facilities comprise an oak framed two bay garage and log store with a wide gravel driveway providing parking for three further cars. Additional land immediately opposite the house may be available by separate negotiation.

The charming village of Bletchingley lies just over a mile away with two convenience stores, a post office, a tearoom and three excellent historic gastro pubs. There are fast rail connections from Merstham station two miles away with direct trains to London Victoria (35 mins), London Bridge (28 mins) as well as London Blackfriars and St Pancras. The larger town of Redhill is approximately three and a half miles and the vibrant town of Reigate with its excellent selection of shops, cafes and restaurants is approximately five miles away, whilst Gatwick airport is about eleven miles. There is an excellent variety of schools in both the state and private sectors including Hawthorns Prep (a short walk), Caterham School, Reigate Grammar and Woldingham School for Girls, along with village primary schools.
