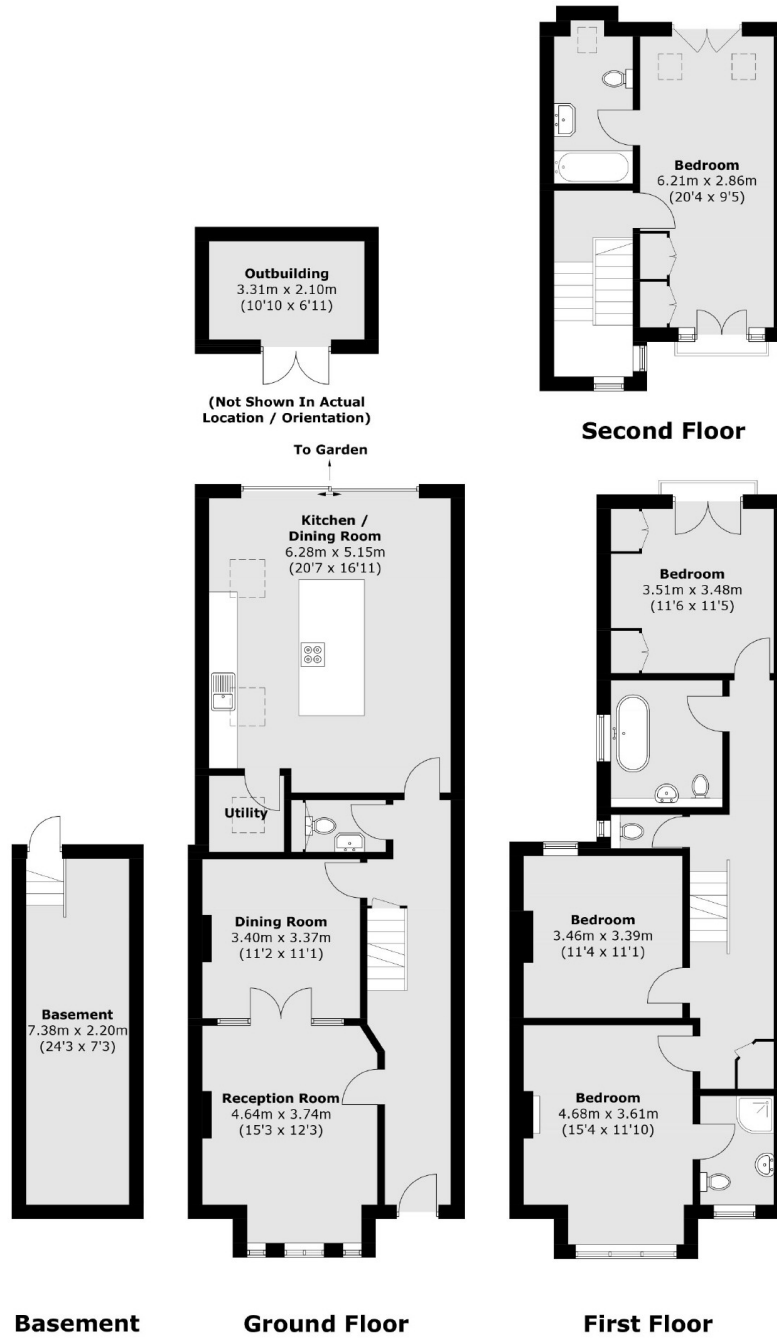
ABOUT THE HOME

A wonderful four double bedroom, three bathroom, Victorian family home. The house amasses more than 2100 sqft and is located on Moyser Road in the heart of the highly sought after area of Furzedown. Internally the layout comprises of a generous double reception room rich in period features and a log burning stove which is divided into a lounge and opulent home office space, a W/C and access to a spacious cellar with ample storage. Completing the ground floor is a recently extended kitchen/diner that boasts a large family island, utility room, integrated induction hob with extractor and full height sliding doors opening out onto a generous south-facing family garden. The garden is part paved and part faux lawned with a large shed/garden room. Returning inside, to the first floor you will find three very spacious double bedrooms with an en-suite to the largest of the three. A well-appointed three piece family bathroom with additional separate WC and stairs leading to converted loft. This offers a principal bedroom with en-suite bathroom and Juliet balcony.

Moyser Road is a sought after location due to its close proximity to the 'outstanding' Penwortham Primary School and Graveney Secondary School as well as several independent coffee shops and stores. The open spaces of Tooting Common are in close proximity.
