Over the years, Swale House changed hands several times until it became the property of Owen Pease, a member of the prominent Pease family of Darlington.

The Pease family were well-known Quakers, with Joseph Pease, a pioneering figure who established the world's first passenger railway, among their ancestors. In 1908, Owen Pease added the Ballroom to the rear of Swale House, where it played host to extravagant gatherings throughout the 1920s and 1930s. By the 1950s, the Ballroom had come under the ownership of the district council, serving as their meeting chamber

for several years. After a period of disuse, The Ballroom was eventually transformed into the luxurious permanent residence that it is today.




