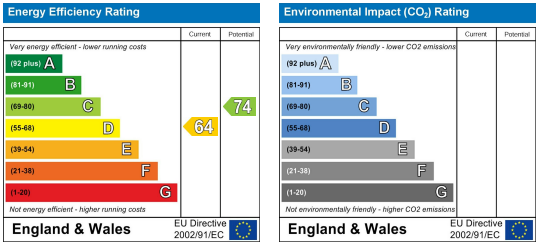
Area Map
